

At the request of various clients, we have enhanced the following features in KiwiPlus 2010:

Bin Tip Scan 'Verify Only' function

This form is used to pre-validate bins against a packrun for tipping, without actually tipping them.

Internal Holds – Special "Supervisor-Only" access for Lifting Holds

A logged-in supervisor can now set any internal hold as 'Supervisor Lift Only'. This means only the supervisor login can release these internal holds from pallets.

Added "QC-User" as a Selectable Field For ECPI Checks

A QC user maintenance table is now available. Records entered here become available for selection in the ECPI entry screen. This allows for more accurate reporting on ECPI checks.

Coolstore Room Mapping Screen

An interactive mapping screen is now available which can create an accurate map of all pallets located in a particular room. From here pallets can be queried or relocated. A pallet list can also be generated from selected pallets as an export to KiwiPlus RF Manager, for those that have this module.

Pallet List Export to Room Map

We have added the ability to export Pallet Lists from CS Pallet List Reports into the Room Map:

1. The "In-Store Pallet List" reports have a new button "Pallet List" on the first tab of the screen. Click on this to run the report and save the result as a PLT file type. The default folder to save these files to is the Pallet Lists directory under the Data folder (it is automatically created if it does not already exist).
2. In the Room Map screen, specify the room and click the "Build Map" button. On the second tab there is a new button available: "Select from...". Click on it to open the selection file dialog. You will need to specify the Pallet List file created previously. Select the file and click the Select button.

3. A new screen will appear showing pallet list details; click on the "List of Pallets" tab to view all the pallets from the list, and specify which pallet you want to import/select in the Room Map (by default, all valid pallets are selected).

4. Click OK to close the screen. The process can be continued, selecting all the appropriate pallets in the current Room Map using the current selection colour.

NOTE: If the exported pallet list has pallets from more than one CS Room, only the pallets located in the displayed Room Map will be imported. The rest will be ignored. This is useful when importing a complex pallet list into more than one CS Room Map.

Only a Supervisor-User can now view other Users' Passwords

The ability for normal users with supervisor access to view other users' passwords has been removed. Only the supervisor login can now view other users passwords. This is to improve control over critical risk features.

Multi-select Function for Loss Code Available on Repack and Fruitloss "No Repack" Screens.

A repack/fruitloss or losses/no repack record can now be entered with multiple loss codes.

GC Lab Message can now update the Completed flag on Associated Packruns if required.

When a maturity area is completed via the GC Lab message screen, the user can also optionally set the completed flag on all associated packruns for the maturity area.

Pallet Enquiry Sticky Notes

Pallet enquiry sticky notes now log user name and time of each note and will show latest note at the top.

KIWI START - Important Warning to All EDI Users:

It is important to note the consequences of processing future DLQ/ILQ transactions against your Kiwi Start packed product:

Please be aware that DLQ's processed against this product **WILL** cause you to lose your Kiwi Start payment for those DLQ'd trays.

When changing materials during this time, **do not use DLQ's**. Instead, manage this with "repals", as this will avoid issues with Kiwi Start payments for that product.

KiwiPlus 2010 Error Log

The primary function of the KiwiPlus Send Error Log is to provide us with a daily update of any KiwiPlus errors that might currently be affecting you.

It is designed to be an automated process which will automatically dispatch an error log file (from a workstation of your choice, and at a nominated time of your choice) without any user intervention required.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU ERROR LOG IS SETUP AND ACTIVATED. Full setup details have been emailed to your EDI Manager but are also available on the Support page of our new website at www.radfordsoftware.co.nz

PaymentsPlus

Now is the time to revise the Default Grower Size Prefix on the Growers form e.g. KS or PL. This is also a good time to check that your kiwi start tray numbers are correct.

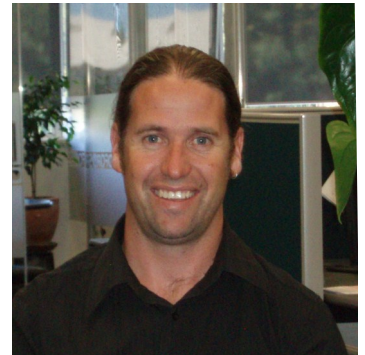
For those people using the "Import Mat. Areas from KiwiPlus" function, when the last of kiwi start product has been imported you may choose not to continue with this procedure / function.

Load out rates – we have created two standard spreadsheets, the first with total class 1 service payment going into one cost centre e.g. column 1 and NSS \$1.60 base rate into column 6 and NSS incentive

into 7. The second spreadsheet has column 1 as Grower incentive, column 2 = Coolstore Incentive, column 3 = Condition Checking, column 4 = Repacking, 5 = Taste, 6 = NSS base and 7 NSS incentive. We will be emailing out instructions along with both spreadsheets before the end of this week.
